Carol A. Flyzik, R.N., 40, died Sept. 11, 2001, in New York City as a passenger aboard the hijacked American Airlines Flight 11.

A longtime resident of Plaistow, she was born in Sidney, N.Y., and raised in Georgetown, Mass. A 1979 graduate of Georgetown High School, she was a member of the school band and drama club and played basketball and field hockey. She attended Bridgewater State College and graduated from Northern Essex Community College with a degree in nursing.

Ms. Flyzik first worked as a staff nurse at Hale Hospital in Haverhill, Mass., from 1985 until 1996, 10 of those years in the emergency department. She was currently supervisor of marketing support at the Framingham, Mass., office of Meditech, Inc.

She was an active member of Gilda's Club and the Human Rights Campaign.

Her life partner was Nancy J. Walsh of Plaistow. Her partner's three children are a daughter, Kristin, and two sons, Kevin and Joe Walsh, all of Plaistow.

Surviving are her mother, Janet Ellis Flyzik of West Newfield, Maine; a brother, Mark S. Flyzik of Plaistow; and two sisters, Linda Pritchard of Brunswick, Maine, and Claudia Flyzik of Atkinson.

A memorial service will be at 4 p.m. Wednesday at First Congregational Church, Andover Street, Georgetown. Arrangements are by Brookside Chapel and Funeral Home.
